## **EXCURSION - KOTOR - PERAST**

#### A HALF DAY EXCURSION

Combined - Bus and boat trip 8.45 - 17.45

#### Starting from Budva / Petrovac or reverse, or Bar/Sutomore or reverse

On the way to Budva stop at a nice viewpoint near Sveti Stefan, from where famous hotel Sveti Stefan is seen, and Milocer - former Yugoslav king summer residence - now days hotel Milocer. Approaching Kotor about 9.30

Sightseeing with the local guide – visit to the cathedral of saint Triphon from 12th century later visit to the national Maritime Museum / all included in the price of the excursion /

After visiting the old town of Kotor which is one of the most interesting old towns along the Adriatic coast -protected by UNESCO, enlisted on UNESCO list of World Cultural Heritage, we'll precede our trip to Perast by bus. At arrival at Perast, group will walk to small town port were they will board the boat for a boat trip towards the island of Gospa of Skrpjela. Boat ride last 10 – 15 minutes one way. Traveling by boat guests will see beautiful Bay and the mountains around. At the island we'll visit the church dedicated to our lady of the rocks.

The island is a manmade island made by sinking old ships filled up with stones / around 17 century Church dedicated to our lady is nicely decorated inside with paintings / 64 / on canvas painted by famous baroque painter from this area. / Tripo Kokolja / a little museum in the church gifts of the sailors from this area given to the church of our lady to save them on their trips on the sea and to keep them and their families healthy. After visit at the island, stop in Perast. Walking - sightseeing tour with the local auide.

Perast once well-known town which flourish in 17 century when had one of the best maritime schools in Europe. Even Russian tsars use to send students to attend the Maritime school in Perast.

Unfortunately, today t a town let is a lonely place, forgotten and left in its glorious history with its stories and legendsfrom the past. Beautiful baroque cathedrals churches and palaces are mostly ruined but still there to remind they had better times long time ago

After the walking sightseeing tour group will have lunch at a local restaurant which terrace is overlooking

the bay and the islands. After lunch return by bus back to your holiday resort


